We already have 22.5 million children out-of-school and when the global pandemic hit, over 50 million school going children have been unable to attend school for past 4 months as the government advised the school closures to ensure health and safety of teachers and students. This is a time for pragmatism and quick action; but it's a moment when more than ever we need mutual needs & collaborative efforts. Nor we can operate without a philosophy. Decisions must be based on humanistic vision of education and human rights framework.

There has been remarkable innovation in the education sector in the response of COVID19 crisis. Online education platform proved to be most engaging with students, parents & communities. But Pakistan needs to have a resilient educational policies, strategies and online systems to support transfer of knowledge in future unprecedented times.

POST COVID-SCHOOLING

The prolonged disclosure of schools has put the entire education system into a deeper crisis, such as wider learning gaps and social/ mental/ physical well-being. TMF is still trying to recover from this learning gap that impacted the students at all levels-primary to university.

This unprecedented change has halted the continuity of education, forced us to rethink how education system can be sustainable and provides us opportunity to innovate learning methodology and equip students with cognitive, creative, social and emotional skills for future.

Graded Home Assignment

All schools were provided with "Graded Home Assignment Packages," subject wise to each student every fourth night. Once these assignments were returned, teachers issued the next assignment and shared and discussed the result of the previous assignment with the students.

Students Back to School

We re-opened schools on September 25, 2020 by implementing strict precautionary measures inside the school around these key areas:

To decrease the environmental impact and combat rising costs, TMF has partnered with SKYELECTRIC for the installation of solar panels in this school. This project will generate 42.03




MWh/year (42,030 kWh/year) which is equivalent to displacing 21 tons CO2/year. In addition, any surplus energy will be resupplied back to the grid system, further reducing costs. TMF aims to achieve a better and sustainable future for all our schools.

2020 Board Results

In March 2020, the Pakistan Board of Examination cancelled the papers of SSC (9th & 10th) and HSSC (11th & 12th) as precautionary measures to control the outbreak of COVID19. It was decided that students will be promoted to next grade on the basis of their previous year's result. 9th grade and 11th grade marks would be reflected on 10th and 12th grades respectively. The decision favoured some students and not others. This year, regular exams will commence according to schedule starting from May 20, 2021.
