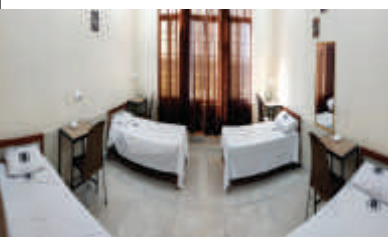

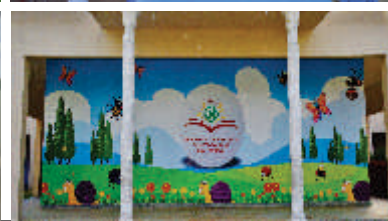
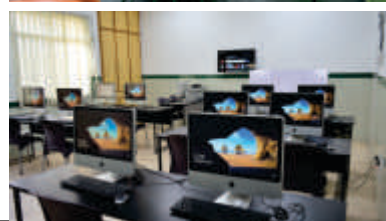

TMF is thrilled to announce the addition of a brand new school campus in Kammanwala District, Sialkot! This fully sponsored, purpose-built facility on 15 marla donated land features 7 classrooms and is equipped with a principal's office, computer lab, washrooms, canteen and security guard room.



The school which caters to the children of labour workers from nearby communities is currently being run on rented property. Shifting to the new campus is scheduled before the new academic session in April 2023. Transport services will also be provided.

## Shoes Give Hope

In collaboration with Bata Pakistan, 31 pairs of shoes were donated to the underprivileged students of Maria Halena TM Primary School, Wajianwala District, Khanewal. Shoes are often an overlooked necessity.



Marginalised parents cannot even afford a pair of school shoes for their children. Though shoes alone do not solve the problems they face, it helps children build their self-esteem and give hope. It also ensures a child's feet are protected from infection and injuries. Moreover, when children receive new shoes, schools report an increase in physical activity and higher attendance.





# EMERGENCY RESPONSE

## Devastating 2022 Pakistan Floods

Pakistan's 2022 monsoon season produced unprecedented rainfall, devastating floods & landslides, affecting millions of people, especially in rural communities. Cascading crises are still unfolding & estimated to persist for months, if not years.

The national emergency directly & indirectly impacted many of our TMF schools, especially in Sindh and Balochistan. There were cancellation of classes and disruption of academic activities because of damaged school buildings, destruction in the areas and problems faced by the students, teachers and parents. Without access to education, these children risk losing their future. TMF responded to this disaster and provided support in the form of survival cash, student sponsorships and repair & maintenance of the school infrastructure.

## Turkiye & Syria Earthquake



As part of Shifa Family, Tameer-e-Millat Foundation in collaboration with Hamidiye Foundation launched an immediate humanitarian response to help the victims of the catastrophic double earthquakes that struck Turkiye & Syria.



Despite the fact that our communities are already grappling with their own crises and hardships, grassroots fundraising efforts were initiated. Schools across our TMF network took action and showed solidarity in support of those affected by the earthquake. They organised awareness campaigns, fundraising activities and donation drives, urging locals to contribute as much as they can in this time of need.

To express their empathy, students also made cards with messages of hope and encouragement for the victims. We hope that these cards will bring a small measure of comfort and positivity to those who are facing such a difficult time, and we are proud of our students for showing such kindness and generosity.

Support Program for Enhancement of Academic Reinforcement

Special circumstances require special measures & adaptability from all key stakeholders including the parents, the child, the teachers & school administration. It is the responsibility of the schools to adopt to a more holistic approach & be prepared for any such circumstances in the future which hinder the course of students learning. In order to fulfil this commitment, we launched SPEAR in several campuses of TMF. The goal of this evening coaching is to provide additional support & individualized attention to the students who may be struggling academically. These classes are designed to help students who are falling behind in their course work or who need extra help in a particular subject area. It is also an opportunity to review and reinforce key concepts and to channelize the energy of the students towards greater productivity. SPEAR caters students of TMF schools & outsiders as well.



## INSET

In-Service Education and Training

Successful school improvement is an inclusive process that involves representative from all stakeholders. However, one particular group of professionals plays an invaluable role. This is our teachers, who lay the groundwork for a successful school improvement plan through effective teamwork. Upholding it, TMF organized In-Service Education & Training (INSET) for their teachers in collaboration with renowned publishers of Pakistan like Oxford University Press, AFAQ and Paramount. Teachers engaged in these sessions to further their educational training and to refresh/upgrade their professional knowledge, skills and practices.
